### **Financial Year 2025: InfoGuard grows by 22 per cent and expands its presence in Germany**

**InfoGuard is consistently continuing on its growth trajectory and looks back on a very successful 2025 financial year. Revenue rose to CHF 87.4 million or EUR 92.4 million (previous year: CHF 71.4 million), corresponding to growth of around 22 per cent. With now over 350 employees, the company underscores its position as one of the largest specialised and leading cyber security providers in the DACH region.**

A key milestone in the past year was the merger with Communication Systems GmbH (now InfoGuard Deutschland GmbH) in mid-2025. This has significantly strengthened InfoGuard's presence in Germany – in particular through the additional locations in Neu-Isenburg near Frankfurt and Düsseldorf.

#### **Strong growth in strategic core areas**

The main drivers of success were the Cyber Defence and SOC services, which grew disproportionately and represent the largest business area. Incident Response developed particularly dynamically: InfoGuard supported more than 350 companies in the DACH region in dealing with cyber-attacks, an increase of over 30 per cent. Managed Security Services (MSS) also continued to perform very well and recorded clear double-digit growth. Security Consulting benefited especially from increasing demand in the areas of AI and cloud security, regulatory requirements such as NIS2, CRA and DORA, as well as practical formats such as tabletop exercises (TTX), which enable companies to strengthen their cyber resilience in a targeted manner.

#### **Scaling capabilities in the DACH region**

With two Security Operations Centres (SOCs) in Switzerland and Germany, which are staffed and operated around the clock, InfoGuard is systematically expanding its operational clout. InfoGuard continues to invest in its teams, its technology platform, automation and the use of AI. In doing so, InfoGuard underlines its commitment to supporting customers throughout the DACH region in defending against and managing cyber threats with maximum response speed, in-depth analysis and operational excellence, backed by 24/7 readiness.

#### **Clear ambition: leading role in cyber resilience and incident response**

“The threat situation in cyberspace continues to intensify, both in terms of frequency and sophistication.
